All items must be clean and in great condition. We do not accept items that are soiled, stained, torn, outdated or have missing/broken parts/pieces.

Please bring a legible list of the items you are donating and include your name and address. We will provide you with an acknowledgement letter that may be used for your tax purposes.

Donations may be dropped off Tuesday, Wednesday and Thursday 10:30 am -3:30 pm.

We currently have a pronounced need for:

- Winter clothing for boys and girls in sizes 5/6 and 7/8
- Toddler car and booster seats (less than five years old)
- New underwear and socks for all ages
- Gently-used lightweight strollers

Clothing

Sizes newborn to 16 years old

Must be clean and in good condition

Underwear must be new

Socks, bras, pants, shirts, shorts, skirts, dresses, bathing suits, pajamas, bath robes, sweaters, jackets, coats, vests, hats, mittens, gloves, scarves, snow pants, snowsuits, leotards, tights, school uniforms.

Footwear

Sizes newborn to 16 years old

Must be clean and in good condition

Dress and casual shoes, sneakers, winter boots, slippers, sandals, water shoes, rain boots, soccer shoes and ice skates.

Infant Items

Must be new or unused

Formula, cereal, baby food, pampers, cloth diapers, diaper wraps, pull-ups, baby swimmers, baby wipes, soap, shampoo, lotion, powder, bottles, pacifiers, and home safety items e.g. plastic electrical outlet covers.

Baby Equipment

Must be clean and in good condition with all working parts

Please include instructional manual if possible

For safety reasons we cannot accept equipment more than 5 years old

Infant and toddler car seats, cribs, bassinets, mattresses, carriages, strollers, baby bouncy seats, highchairs, walkers, playpens, jolly jumpers, potty chairs, bath tubs, sassy seats baby back packs, swings, changing tables, gates, baby monitors, diaper bags.

Toys

Newborns to 12 years old

Must be clean and in good condition with no broken or missing pieces

No violent toys such as guns or swords

Educational toys, computer games, stuffed animals, dolls, action figures, cars, trucks, dress up clothes, puzzles, board games, DVD and VHS movies and Halloween costumes.

Books

Newborn to 16 years old

Must be in good condition with no missing or torn pages

Children's books, coloring books, multi-cultural books and parenting resource books

School Supplies

Must be new or unused

Back packs, pencils, pens, erasers, calculators, sharpeners, binders, notebooks, folders, organizers, rulers, staplers, staples, pencil boxes, index cards, highlighters, lunch bags, and hand sanitizer.

Miscellaneous

Must be clean and in good condition

Hair accessories must be new or unopened
